Issues and Themes for August 2024

- Deaf service user checked if had BSL interpreter booked by Walsall Manor Hospital for appointment. They checked, but had not booked one.
- Patient waiting 12 months for knee operation.
- Relative trying to find personal care support such as nail cutting but finding it difficult to identify simple service.
- Patient removed as NHS patient at their local dentist without knowledge/consent.
- Waiting times for Bariatric surgery 12 months plus.
- Patient at Walsall Manor Hospital waiting a number of months for contact from GP referral/

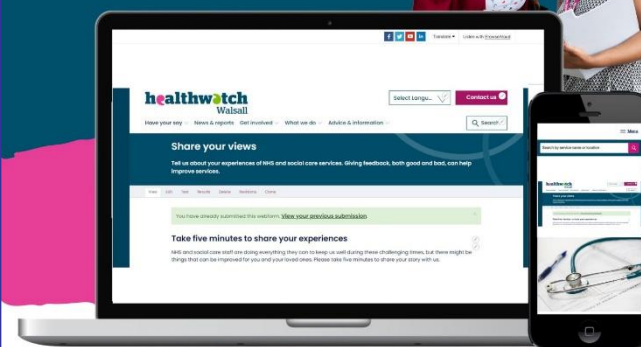
