Issues and Themes for August 2025

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- Relatives seeking information about support and equipment available for a recent amputee patient.
- Patient attempted to book a GP appointment via Accurx, but the service was not available (turned off). Patient then telephoned the GP practice, but was advised to book via Accurx, which remained unavailable.
- Excellent service given to patient by the Orthoptics Department at Walsall Manor Hospital.
- Lack of GP visits being made to a care home, service sending nurses and care managers only.
- Patient with ongoing mental health concerns reports difficulty accessing care. Although previously advised by their GP to make contact when needed, they have been unable to do so due to reception staff gatekeeping and restricting access.

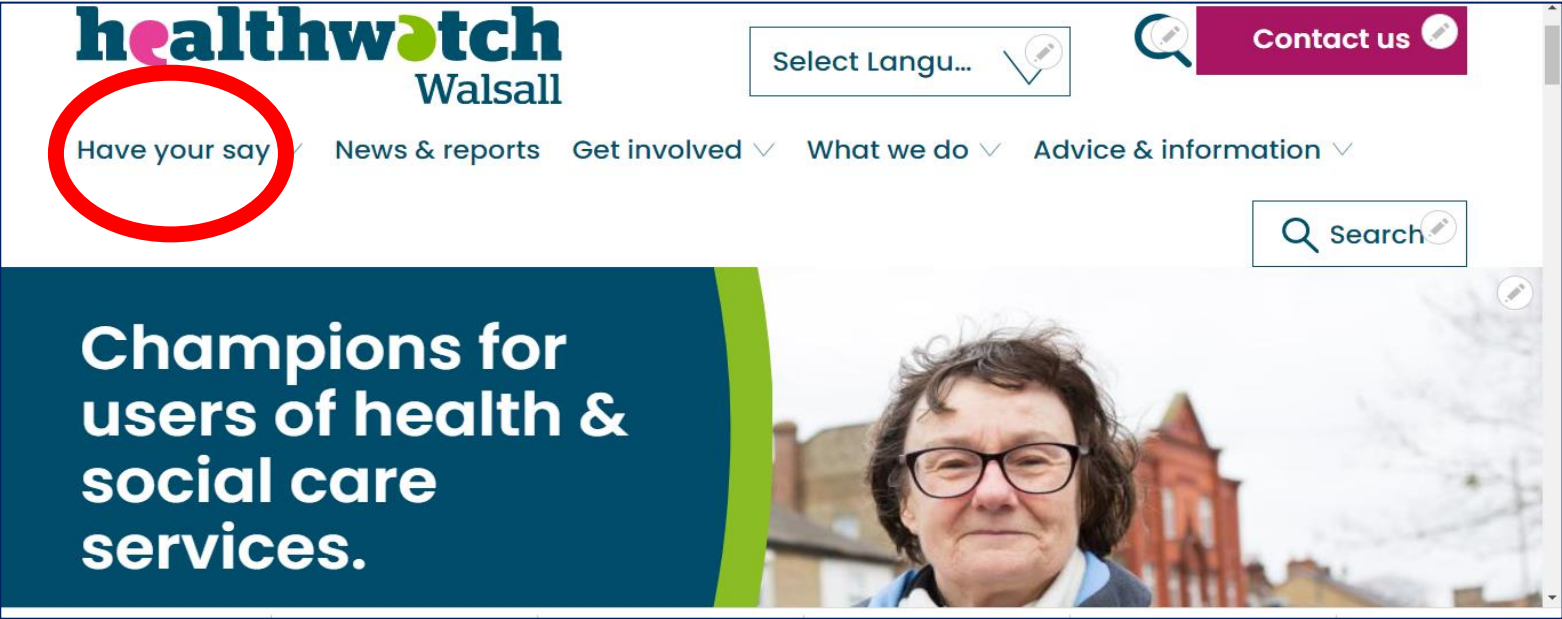
