Issues and Themes for May 2025

- Patient who had not accessed their GP in the last two years was removed from GP list.
- Patient waited for an X-ray following a referral but did not receive an appointment. The patient had to follow up with PALS directly to chase the appointment.
- Person with dementia was expected to travel to a memory clinic appointment but felt too scared to attend. Therefore, Healhtwatch Walsall requested the service to be provided at the local GP practice.
- Enquiry about aids and equipment. Signposted to Local Authority social care Service.
- Signposted patients to Extra GP Appointments.
- Service user said they were asked to get blood test but could not get done at own GP location so told to attend Walsall Manor Hospital.
- Attending a Dementia Café visited by patients and carers, Healthwatch Walsall were told that Bloxwich Medical Practice is a very good GP practice.
- Patient been told two different things by two different hospital professionals.
- Person asked if any groups available to offer companionship. Advised to contact social prescriber.
- New mum feels there is no support to breast feed, was told to use a bottle to feed.
