Issues and Themes for September 2025

Insight Report

- Service user expressed positive experience at Walsall Podiatry services.
- Service user struggling to get a response from Walsall PALS.
- Service user raised concerns about patient waiting/overcrowding in Walsall Pathology department.
- Service user unable to get in touch with GP feeling this is due to barrier of reception staff.
- Walsall resident received 'out of area' care and said care was excellent.
- Patients visiting Walsall Emergency and Urgent Care centre waiting times up to 12 hours.
- Person returns home (another country) to get scans and results for neurology issue. Waiting time here in UK NHS is months/years.
- Patients still unaware of 'Extra GP Appointments' available in Borough.

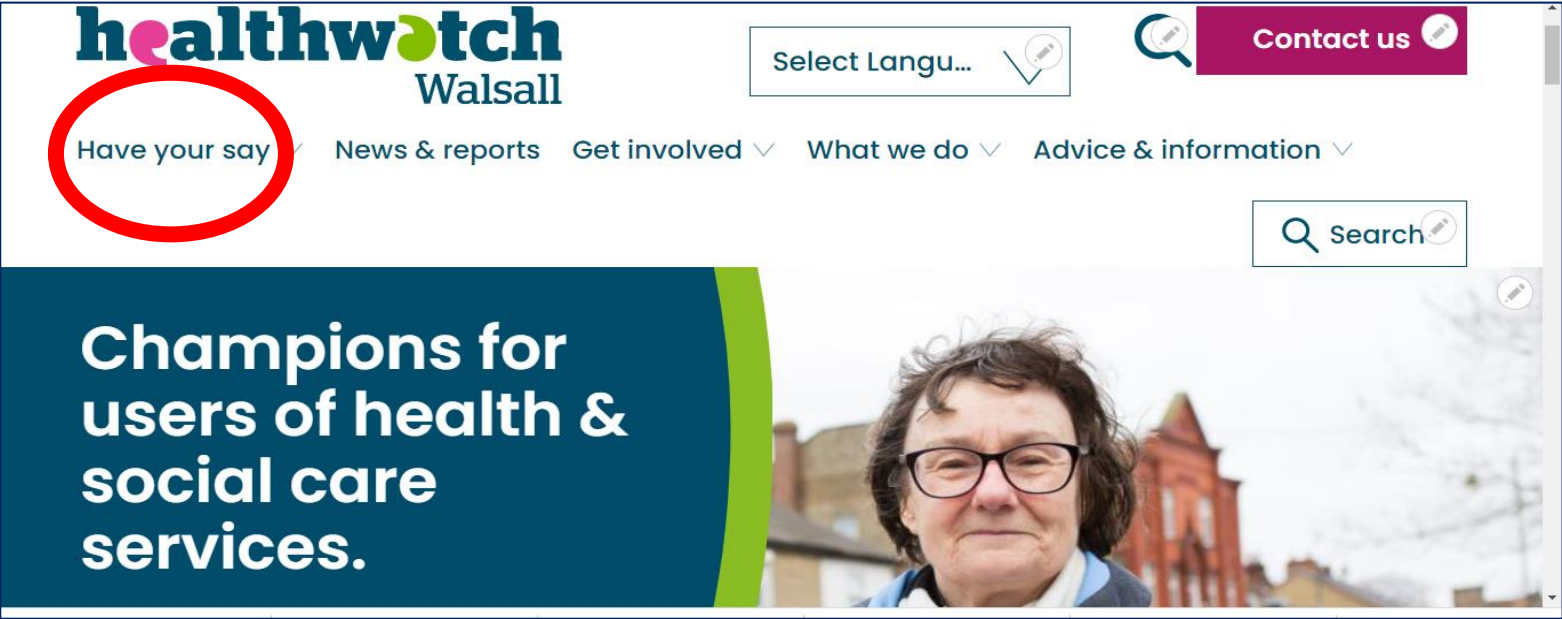
